Dear Annuitant,

Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education Annuitant Health Care Program (AHCP) **Open Enrollment period is May 20 through June 7, 2024**. This Open Enrollment period is for your coverage effective July 1, 2024.

What is AHCP Open Enrollment?

AHCP Open Enrollment is your only opportunity to make a change to your AHCP coverage without experiencing a qualified life event. The following changes are permitted during this period:

- Add or drop dependents to your AHCP coverage;
- Terminate your AHCP coverage;

ATTENTION: If you are not making one of the above changes during AHCP Open Enrollment, there is no action required on your part for your AHCP coverage to continue beyond July 1, 2024.

Are there other AHCP coverages available?

There are no plan choices available to annuitants.

Can I make a change to my AHCP coverage other than during AHCP Open Enrollment?

Yes. You may add/drop dependents or even cancel AHCP coverage, but only if you experience a qualified life event. Examples of common qualified life events are:

- Marriage or divorce;
- Death of spouse/dependent;
- Dependent is no longer a full-time student or becomes a full-time student;
- · Becoming Medicare eligible;
- Annuitant/dependent gain of other coverage;
- Dependent loss of other coverage;

It is your responsibility to report qualified life events within 60 days of the event to the AHCP office.

How do I make changes to my coverage for AHCP Open Enrollment?

The required forms and documentation must be received by this office by June 7, 2024.

Other Important Notes -

Medicare Advantage Transition: Effective January 1, 2025, all Medicare eligible retirees and/or dependents residing within the United States that are enrolled in Signature 65 groups 064222-00 through 064222-09 will be transitioned to the new customized Freedom Blue PPO Medicare Advantage plan. <u>These individuals will receive separate communications throughout the year about this upcoming transition</u>.

Turning 65: This office will contact you approximately 90 days prior to becoming Medicare eligible regarding changes to your coverage upon turning 65. Turning 65 is not an open enrollment event and you do not need to contact this office at this time.
